Representative Matters

- Successfully negotiated six-figure settlement of expected permanent total disability claim by working the employer, its third party administrator, and excess carrier. Settlement involved resolution of future indemnity liability and establishment of an approved Medicare Set-Aside Trust.
- Prevailed in Mandamus action in the 10th District Court of Appeals, challenging the start date of permanent total disability benefits. The Decision created leverage to settle future exposure for self-insured employer.
- Terminated temporary total disability compensation using coordinated video surveillance in conjunction with an independent medical examination. Substance of video surveillance combined with examination findings created leverage resulting in settlement of the underlying claim, claimant's formal resignation from employment, as well as a no-rehire agreement in a claim with significant future liability.
